

## Facilities/Housing

The Camp Zion staff will work hard to ensure that your group has a good stay and your retreat is successful. We provide tasty meals and comfortable housing, and are always available to help in any way possible. We will work with you in advance to assign housing and facilities that best serve your group.

The Bayview Lodge meeting room overlooks Green Bay and has a fireplace. The Fireside Lodge has a lower level meeting room. Both rooms are carpeted, have adjacent bathrooms, and can be set up to seat about 75 adults.

Sleeping rooms are carpeted with tiled bathrooms. Housing options include:

- Fireside Lodge capacity: 68; two upper level sleeping rooms of 24 each, one lower level room sleeping 20. Upper level rooms may be divided using a pocket door. No AC.
- Upper Dining Hall capacity: 32; four rooms sleeping 8 each. Bathroom/shower room is shared between two rooms. AC.
- Dining Hall Main Room seats 75 adults or 90 children, has fireplace, porch, canteen, and the complimentary coffee.
- Bayview Lodge capacity: 6, two rooms, Hillside-2, Bayside-4. Bathrooms and meeting room adjacent.
- Annex capacity: 12. Bathroom adjacent.
- Rustic cabins (2), capacity: 14 each. Not winterized, or carpeted, bathrooms in nearby Throne Room.

Available recreational equipment: rowboats and playaks (life jackets required), volleyball, cross-country skis, snow tubes, broomball equipment, basketball, softball, soccer, game equipment.

Video projector, white boards, tables, portable sound system, ping-pong table, TV/VCR/DVD, outdoor amphitheater campfire area and waterfront campfire area.

## Directions

### **Points of Interest from Camp Zion**

- To Peninsula State Park north entrance: Hwy. 42 south through Ephraim. Watch for State Park signs. South park entrance is several miles further south on Hwy. 42. Park sticker required.
- To Newport State Park: Hwy. 42 north to County Road NP, follow signs to park. Park sticker required.
- To Gills Rock/Island Clipper: Hwy. 42 north. Northport car ferry dock is several miles north of Gills Rock on Hwy. 42.
- To Ellison Bay Town Park Ice Rink: Garrett Bay Rd. south, approx. 2 miles. On east side of road, one block north of the Post Office.
- To Sister Bay Public Ice Rink: Hwy 42 south into Sister Bay. Turn left on Mill Rd, bear left on Park Lane. Skates and helmets are available for rental. 920.854.7014

### **Hiking Directions to Door Bluff**

Meet at the Big "Z", and walk north on private gravel road one block to cul-de-sac. "Red Dot Trail" trailhead is about 20 feet past a rock fence, then off to the left heading north. Final destination is a small 10 x 15 clearing, 175' above the bay, about 15-20 minutes from camp.

### **Driving Directions to Camp Zion**

- From Milwaukee, I-43 north to Green Bay, north on Hwy. 57 to Sturgeon Bay. Go north on 42 into Ellison Bay. OR, I-43 north to exit 152 (Waldo Blvd.) Go east to Hwy. 42, north on 42 into Ellison Bay.
- From Green Bay, take Hwy. 57 north to Sturgeon Bay. Go north on 42 into Ellison Bay.
- From Hwy. 42, turn left (north) on Garrett Bay Rd. (just before the historic "Gus Klenke Garage"). Turn left on Door Bluff Rd. (west). Go .8/mile and turn right on Door Bluff Lane. At "T", go left to camp.
- For Mapquest Directions, use 12701 Door Bluff Rd. Ellison Bay, WI 54210 as your ending point.

## Contract Policies

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As a guest group, we agree to sign and return the contract with the indicated deposit **within 30 days of receipt of this letter**, or it is understood that Camp Zion is free to negotiate with another group for the activity dates shown.

Guest Groups understand that cancellation of the contract is possible only if Camp Zion is able to arrange a replacement group.

Deposit moneys cannot be refunded, but may be transferred to another date within a year. Final payment is due upon arrival unless other arrangements have been made. Camp Zion reserves the right to book another group simultaneously if capacity allows.

Guest groups agree to submit a final count no later than 7 days preceding the activity. If actual attendance falls below the final count, guest groups agree to meet entire financial obligation to Camp Zion for the final count amount, or the guaranteed minimum, whichever is greater.

Payment must be made with a church or organization check upon arrival, unless prior arrangements have been made.

Guest groups agree to respect the beliefs of Camp Zion as set forth in their Declaration of Faith, and do nothing by word or act that will in any way detract from the testimony of this ministry.

Guest groups agree to abide by the guidelines described in this contract, as well as those given by staff members and posted on the grounds. The group leader accepts the responsibility of communicating these guidelines to the participants and will follow through to ensure compliance.

Guest group agrees to assume responsibility for damages to facilities and equipment and may be charged accordingly.

**Guest group agrees to provide Camp Zion with a certificate of insurance (ACORD Form) listing Camp Zion as "additional insured".** If no ACORD form is received, guest group leader assumes the responsibility to make sure each person has adequate insurance coverage. Camp insurance is secondary in nature only.

So that the camp staff can best accommodate the group, guest group agrees to submit a planned program no later than 7 days preceding the activity.

## Camp Zion Guidelines

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For everyone's benefit, we ask you to please read the following guidelines and abide by them. Please share them with your campers and leaders.

Camp Zion does not furnish pillows, linens, blankets, towels, etc.

There must be one responsible adult supervisor for every ten school age participants.

Grounds curfew and quiet hours begin at 11:00 PM. Outside activities should conclude by 11:00 PM. Please be respectful of nearby camp neighbors.

Meals are scheduled for the following times: Breakfast: 8:30AM; Lunch: 12:30PM; Supper: 5:30PM, Brunch: 9:00AM. Half-hour deviations earlier or later may be arranged in advance by noting it on the contract. Promptness to meals is appreciated.

The Canteen is available for snacks. Please note desired Canteen times on the contract.

All bodily injury or illness must be reported to the Director before leaving the property.

A member of the Camp Zion staff will give a welcome and orientation to your group at your first convenient meeting.

Use of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs is not permitted.

Dress code: Modesty and good taste are expected at all times. Shirt and shoes must be worn in camp and buildings.

Amplified music outdoors or indoor music that can be heard outside is not permitted.

Use of candles is not allowed.

Wisconsin state law requires that all medication brought to camp by a camper under 18 years of age be kept by the sponsoring organization's adult leadership in a locked unit, and to be administered by those leaders. Medications should be clearly labeled.

## Waiver/Release

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In consideration of acceptance to Camp Zion, the guest group indemnifies and holds harmless Camp Zion, its owners, agents, associates, staff, from any and all liability, claims, damage, injury or illness sustained its campers. I/we understand and acknowledge that camp activities may have inherent dangers that no amount of care, caution, instruction, or expertise can eliminate, and I/we expressly and voluntarily assume all risk of personal injury sustained while participating in all activities whether or not caused by the negligence of the released parties.

## Declaration of Faith

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1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired and only infallible, authoritative Word of God, and our rule for faith and practice.
