

## *Cabin Counselor*

**Purpose:** To oversee, care for, love, and to minister to a group of youth campers.

**Status:** Volunteer

**Responsible to:** Program Director

**Direct Charges:** Assistant Cabin Counselors

**Other Relationships:** Program Director, Chaplain

### **Qualifications:**

Be at least 18 years of age.

Be mature, yet able to enjoy being with kids and have fun.

Has prior experience working with youth.

### **General Responsibilities:**

- Aid in keeping the cabins clean and orderly at all times.
- Be available to assist Camp Zion as individual skills and the schedule allows.

### **Specific Responsibilities:**

1. Lead brief, evening cabin devotions.
2. Assist with games, activities, swim times.
3. Participate in the responsibility for the health, safety, and general well-being of campers.
4. Be available to help in other areas as necessary and the schedule permits.
5. Be responsible for camper wake-up and bedtime supervision. Camper LIGHTS OUT times vary by age; 9:30PM younger campers, 10:30PM for older campers.
6. Be alert to situations and camper needs throughout day.
7. Be on the alert for bullying. Do not allow!
8. Keep log of major spiritual decisions.

## *Assistant Cabin Counselor*

### **Qualifications:**

Be 16 years of age, or entering sophomore year in high school, Prior youth work experience desired.

### **General Responsibilities:**

- Aid in keeping the cabins clean and orderly at all times.
- Be available to assist Camp Zion as individual skills and the schedule allows.

### **Specific Responsibilities:**

1. Assist with games, activities, swim times
2. Never leave campers alone at night.
3. Maintain awareness of where kids are at all times
4. Pro-active engagement
5. Assist with leading cabin devotions
6. Participate in the responsibility for the health, safety, and general well-being of campers.
7. Assist with camper wake-up and bedtime supervision.
8. Be available to help in other areas as necessary and the schedule permits.
9. Be alert to situations and camper needs throughout day.
10. Watch for bullying, DO NOT TOLERATE.
