### **Specific Responsibilities:**

1. Recruit lifeguards prior to summer season.

- 2. Train lifeguards in all aspects of job.
- 3. Prepare waterfront for summer, put away for fall.
- 4. Manage lifeguard rotation schedules.
- 5. Enforce waterfront safety rules.
- 6. Ensure boats are ready to go before they are needed.
- 7. Coordinate waterfront activities and schedule with Program Directors.

#### **Specific Responsibilities:**

Be present and assist as directed during all activities on waterfront, including swims, flag-raising, exercises, boating, campfire, etc.

Thoroughly clean and mop Fireside and First Aid bathrooms, AND your living quarters.

Prep and equip boats, (gas, motors, safety chains, oars, etc.)

Prep & Equip waterfront prior to scheduled times. Keep waterfront clean and safe.

- DNR Safe-Boating Certificate.

#### **During Swim Periods:**

LIFEGUARDING IS PREVENTING ACCIDENTS FROM HAPPENING.

Have whistle, sunglasses, oil ready to go. Use your whistle!

Follow prescribed guarding rotation and good guard habits.

Be familiar with rules.

Supervise swim tests.

#### And...

- 8. Keep boathouse clean; no campers please.
- 9. Sweep, mop Dining hall, kitchen, canteen, storage room, restrooms.
- 10. Assist in special events, check with Waterfront Director first.
- 11. When filling water balloons for water balloon fights, keep out about 3-4 to bomb those that escaped getting wet during fight.
